MAINTENANCE WORKER I (part-time)
City of Duluth - Public Works Department

The City of Duluth, Georgia (pop. 27,000) is accepting applications for the part-time position of **MAINTENANCE WORKER I**. This position is generally 24 hours per week as needed, with no fringe benefits.

This employee will be involved in all aspects of Public Works duties--the cleaning and maintenance of the Downtown, Town Green, and Festival Center areas; assisting with set-up and clean-up of special events; street repair; storm drain maintenance; building and grounds maintenance; erecting and removing memorial markers and flags; city dumpster; and custodial work. Employees are required to perform heavy physical labor in all types of outdoor weather using a variety of tools and equipment.

A High School diploma, state-issued GED, or equivalent is required. Previous experience in similar type of work is preferred. All candidates are subject to a background investigation, including criminal history, driving history, drug testing and medical exams.

Starting salary is \$12.88-\$13.55 depending on qualifications. Work is regularly performed during the daytime hours with specific days based on the needs of the Public Works Department, but there is some flexibility. Some after-hours work may be required.
